Ripe red cherry color with garnet-colored rim, dense and opaque.

Intense on the nose, exhibits a nice bouquet of candied black fruits and spices like star anise, clove and vanilla blended with slightly toasted nuances from its ageing in oak barrels.

Lovely in the mouth, meaty and yummy with velvety and sweet tannins, long finish. The most representative expression of the truly character of Ribera de Duero wines. Wide drinking window.
